(San Diego, CA February 10, 2023). San Diego Musical Theatre announces the first production of their 2023 season, *ANYTHING GOES*, February 10 - March 12, 2023 (press opening on Saturday, February 11) at the SDMT Stage in Kearny Mesa.

The S. S. American is sailing between New York and England with a comically colorful assemblage of passengers: Reno Sweeney, a popular nightclub singer and former evangelist, her pal Billy Crocker, a lovelorn Wall Street broker who has come aboard to try to win the favor of his beloved Hope Harcourt (who is engaged to another passenger, Sir Evelyn Oakleigh), and a second-rate conman named Moonface Martin, aka "Public Enemy #13." Song, dance, and farcical antics ensue as Reno and Moonface try to help Billy win the love of his life. A hilarious shipboard romp wrapped in one of Cole Porter's most magical scores. Music, dance, laughs and the age-old tale of boy meets girl... Anything Goes is delightful, delicious and de-lovely.
