San Diego Musical Theatre Announces the 2025 Season to be Performed on the SDMT Stage

San Diego Musical Theatre announces the 2025 season of Broadway musicals to be performed on the SDMT Stage in Kearny Mesa, San Diego. Their 18th season will bring stories of love, justice, imagination, and just a bit of duality. Through breathtaking musical and dance performances, the 2025 season is guaranteed to bring viewers copious joy and memories to take with them forever from the theatre.

Opening their 2025 season will be the classic musical: *Hello, Dolly!* In this golden age blockbuster hit, a meddlesome matchmaker arrives in Yonkers set on finding a match for the miserly Horace Vandergelder. Bursting with humor, romance, high-energy dancing and some of the greatest songs in musical theatre history, this show is boisterous and charming from start to finish. Using her astonishing wit, intelligence, and abilities, Matilda dreams of a better life, and isn't afraid to turn things upside-down to get it with the help of her friends. Jekyll & Hyde, SDMT's fourth show of 2025, will bring us all a bit of spooky thrill just in time for the Halloween season!
