to play! We will consider one to two AEA actors if local hire. No housing available. The role of HERTZ KLINEMAN has been cast. Seeking an understudy for this role.

Rock of Ages contains moments of intimacy, sexualization, and crude humor that are central to its campy, larger-than-life style. Our production will approach all such material with care, intention, and respect for both performers and audience. We are seeking actors who understand the show's over-the-top comedic tone and are excited by its bold, playful spirits and artists who are comfortable meeting the physical, stylistic, and storytelling requirements with professionalism and a willingness to fully "play" within this heightened world.

CHARACTER BREAKDOWN

DREW: An appealing, good-guy rocker with great, easy comedic timing, a boyish charm with vulnerability, and a very strong high rock tenor voice. Guitar skills a plus, but not required. Drew works at the legendary Bourbon Room hoping and waiting for his dreams to come true. He finds an instant attraction to Sherrie, the new arrival from the Midwest, who encourages him to go after his

dreams. Character identifies as male. (Vocal Range: Bb3- D5)

LONNY: The narrator of the piece. Charming, mischievous, welcoming, vibrant personality, a guy who would be fun to spend one drunken night with. Strong, honest comedic timing/improv skills and strong high rock vocals. Character identifies as male. (Vocal Range: D3-D5)

SHERRIE: An innocent Midwestern girl stepping right off the bus into a new world to pursue her dreams of stardom. Strong comedic timing, strong rock belt, good movement ability. Character identifies as female. (Vocal Range: G3-F5)

DENNIS DUPREE: A classic stoner type guy who runs the famous Bourbon Room club. Torn about whether he should sell the club to Hertz, a German businessman. Very strong comedic timing. A laid-back, easy-going, real dude. Bari-tenor rock vocals. Character identifies as male. (Vocal Range: D3-G4)

STACEE JAXX: A sexy rock star. Decided to leave his successful rock band to try it solo. Self-important, confident, intriguing in all the wrong ways, the ultimate bad boy. Great strong comedic timing with a strong high rock tenor voice. Guitar skills a plus, but not required. Character identifies as male. Will also play Sherrie's FATHER. (Vocal Range: C3-Eb5)

JUSTICE: A strong presence and an easy sensuality about her. Once a performer, she now operates a gentleman's club where Sherrie winds up working. Takes on the maternal role for the girls that work for her. Strong, soulful vocals needed. **Particularly interested in a black Trans/Nonbinary/Drag performer/actor for this role!** Character identifies as female. Will also play Sherrie's MOTHER. (Vocal Range: G3-Db5)

HERTZ KLINEMANN: This role has been pre-cast. Seeking an ensemble member to understudy. An attractive older German male. Uptight, cold, intimidating businessman trying to buy up the Strip to develop it. The bad guy of the piece. Strong comedic timing and baritone rock vocals. Character identifies as male. (Vocal Range: F3- G#4)

FRANZ KLINEMANN: Hertz's son, young (20s) German male. Works for his father but not by choice. Pressured and intimidated by his father. Shy, gentle with a big heart. Strong rock baritenor vocals and great comedic timing. Character identifies as male. (Vocal Range: Db3-E5)

REGINA: A fun, strong, hippie who fights against the attempted takeover of The Sunset Strip. Strong comedic timing, belt vocals. Character identifies as female. (Vocal Range: A3-Eb5)

MAYOR/JA'KEITH/ENSEMBLE: A strong comedic actor to play multiple roles, with a great rock/soul sound, and strong dance/movement ability. Character identifies as male. (Must attend the ENSEMBLE dance call)

JOEY PRIMO/ENSEMBLE: A young (20's) actor with the rocker sensibility, strong rock tenor and strong/ dance/movement ability. Character identifies as male. (Must attend the ENSEMBLE dance call)

ENSEMBLE: Seeking a wide variety of actors, ages 18+, of all ethnicities, gender identities and body types! (Particularly interested in seeing Trans/Nonbinary/Drag performers for our Ensemble of characters as well). Must have good comedic timing to play numerous roles. Will understudy many of the principal roles. Strong rock vocals and movement/dance abilities required. (Must attend the ENSEMBLE dance call)
